The tables in the annex contain the names of EMJD doctoral candidates selected by the consortium on a main list and a reserve list.

All candidates mentioned on the main list are recommended to be awarded an EMJD fellowship for a period of three years which will vary from 111.600 EUR to 129.900 EUR depending on the type of research programme (laboratory / non-laboratory based).

Candidates on the reserve list might be awarded an Erasmus Mundus fellowship in replacement of candidates figuring on the main list.

Regarding the admission of doctoral candidates to Erasmus Mundus Joint Doctorate Programme the existence of the COUNCIL DIRECTIVE 2005/71/EC of 12 October 2005 regarding the mobility of researchers as well as information on "scientific" and other types of visa should be noted. This Directive provides that EU Member States shall facilitate the admission procedure for third-country nationals who participate in European Union programmes enhancing mobility towards or within the European Union.
